

2019 Safety Awards

The 2019 Safety Awards were presented during the online Business Meeting.

Awards include the Safety Diamond Club Award, Safety Award of Excellence, and the Safety Award of Achievement. The three award categories are described below:

Safety Diamond Club Award

The Safety Diamond Club Award is presented to any Fabricator or Affiliate Member who experienced the appropriate amount of man-hours or time worked without an OSHA recordable incident for five consecutive years.

Safety Award of Excellence

Recognizing member companies whose employees have experienced a ZERO (0.00) OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate for the previous calendar year.

Safety Award of Achievement

Recognizing Member companies that experienced a minimum 10% reduction in the OSHA Total Recordable Incident Rate, with no fatalities, during the 2019 calendar year, as compared with the average Total Recordable Incident Rate for the three previous years.

Update Regarding the 2021 STI/SPFA Annual Meeting

Attention Shop Fabricated Licensees

- UL is now performing virtual inspections via online mechanisms to perform their regular inspections. Facilities need to have a real time mechanism to participate in these inspections (i.e. Zoom, Skype, Android phone, Goto Meeting, Teams) and must have wireless access to their entire shop that could be subject to inspection. STI members should be ready to respond to a request.

- UL is sending letters to UL file holders to plan
 the review of their storage tank related files in

NAM Reports on Manufacturers Outlook for Second Quarter

The vast majority of manufacturers have kept their doors open, according to the <u>Manufacturers' Outlook</u> <u>Survey</u> for the second quarter of 2020.

The bottom line: Despite a historic drop in optimismto 33.9% from last quarter's 75.6% and challenging business conditions, the vast majority (98.7%) of manufacturers have continued or only temporarily halted operations.

Combating the virus: The survey also shows that manufacturers are finding innovative solutions to keep businesses running and to protect workers and communities:

- * Almost 22% are retooling to produce personal protective equipment
- * **67**% are reengineering processes to reflect COVID-19 safety protocols
- * 12% are completely reevaluating the mission of the

Next steps: The NAM has been urging policymakers to take up its "American Renewal Action Plan" and to enact targeted liability reforms that will protect businesses that take part in the COVID-19 response effort

NAM President and CEO Jay Timmons: "While these numbers show that we've faced difficult circumstances and that there is a challenging road ahead, manufacturers have proven that with our grit, determination and patriotic spirit, we can overcome any challenge facing the nation."
