



Superstorm Sandy fueling facilities

Tanknology assists UST site operators

Shortly after Superstorm Sandy hit the East Coast, STI/SPFA member Tanknology began assisting gas stations and other fueling facilities to assess damage and get back into operation.

"Fortunately, in many cases a visual inspection and manual tightness test with the automatic tank gauge is all that's needed," said Allen Porter, Tanknology president in a November press release. The company set up a Storm



Recovery webpage to help operators determine what steps to take depending on the extent of damage.

"A few years ago, we helped the EPA develop its Underground Storage Tank Flood Guide for situations like Superstorm Sandy." Porter noted that this publication is available for download from Tanknology's website.
