





# **Inside STI/SPFA**

#### **Board and committee actions**

All committees and the Board of Directors hold meetings at the Annual Meeting. Here is a summary of actions taken at the meetings in Tucson:





- There are two Steel Water Pipe webinars scheduled, in May and November. The Steel Pipe Section is also establishing a Century Club.
- The 2013 Annual Meeting is set for March 23-26 in Bonita Springs, FL. This is a joint meeting with the Pressure Vessel Manufacturers Association.
- The Safety & Health Committee has made a number of self-audit checklists available in the Members Only section of the website.
- The Technical Committee will develop a UST repair standard and a graywater/rainwater steel tank fabrication standard in response to requests from regulators.
- The Affiliate Committee voted to have the New Product of the Year Award voted on by Fabricator Members, rather than Affiliate Members.
- A special one-year Fireguard warranty was approved for gasoline storage tanks subject to CARB regulations.
- The Board approved modifying our Vision Statement and Mission Statement to include "water" with any "pipe" references. This is to distinguish that STI/SPFA's Pipe Section refers to steel water pipe.

#### 12 Series standards under review

Staff member Dana Schmidt participated in API committee meetings in Washington in mid-April. No formally proposed changes to the API

API Standards Committee

standard were submitted, but here are a few discussion highlights:

- API Monogram program compared to UL listing.
- Proprietory bolted tank designs.
- Consideration to increase the maximum capacity of the API 12F tank specification.
- Discouraging use of thief hatches as emergency vent devices.
- Use of contoured clean-outs rather than rectangular openings.

The API Inspector Summit is scheduled for January 2013 and will cover both upstream, midstream (refining) and downstream topics. API is seeking leaders for these three tracks.

## "Friend of the industry" passes

#### John P. Hartmann

John P. Hartmann, 76, died in Evanston, Illinois, on April 2. Remembering Hartmann, STI/SPFA's Wayne Geyer said, "John was a real friend to the petroleum equipment industry. He served as an STI consultant on several projects, including the STI QuickSpec series of CD's. John was an advocate of bringing together different factions of the industry to discuss important issues, even if it was over a casual lunch."

John served as the Petroleum Equipment Institute's consultant to develop its PEI RP 100 when underground storage tank regulations were being promulgated in the late 1980's. PEI RP 100 is now nationally recognized as the foremost RP on tank installation. John also published the magazine *Petroleum Equipment & Technology*, one of the first glossy, technically based industry magazines. John will be missed.
