



CAN/ULC-S602 covers the design and construction of aboveground steel non-pressure tanks intended for installation inside or outside buildings for the storage of combustible liquid intended to be used as heating fuel and/or generator fuel; and lubricating oil.



Changes to this edition of CAN/ULC-S602 include:

- New alternative requirement to determine equivalence of steel tank material;
- Enhanced welding requirements;
